CHAP. 66.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to confer any banking privileges on the said company, nor the right to issue any note in the nature of a bank note.

Banking forbid

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall be, and is hereby made perpetual; *Provided nevertheless*, that the Legislature of Maryland reserve to itself the power of altering, amending or repealing any of the provisions thereof, after the expiration of the year eighteen hundred and fifty.

Right reserved to repeal &c.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That each Director and the President, who shall appear to have directed or assented thereto, shall be personally liable for any losses, deficiencies or failures, arising from any misapplication of the funds of said corporation, contrary to the provisions of this act.

Personal liability of president and directors

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the affairs of the corporation hereby intended to be created, shall be at all times subject to the inspection of any committee of this branch of the Legislature, or of any officer of the State, who may be deputed by either branch for that purpose.

Right of inspection reserved

CHAPTER 66.

*An act relating to Constables fees, in Worcester county, and for other purposes.* Passed Feb. 19, 1836

WHEREAS, some sections of the county are very remote from the jail, thereby subjecting the constables to great inconvenience, and the compensation not adequate to the labor performed in the delivering over to the jailor, persons committed:—Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act all Constables in Worcester county, shall be entitled to receive in addition to the fifty cents now allowed, six and a fourth cents for each mile travelled in
