Resolution in favor of Benjamin Seegar and J. M. Faulkner. Passed April 2,
1836.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Benjamin Seegar, engrossing clerk of the House of Delegates, and to Joshua M. Faulkner, engrossing clerk to the Senate, the sum of fifty dollars each, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, as a further remuneration for their services during the present session.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Hammond and Daniel C. Digges, the sum of twenty-eight dollars each; to Alexander Tyler, the sum of sixteen dollars, and to Louis G. Gassaway, John G. Proud, Junior, Charles H. Stephen, and John H. Boyle, the sum of twelve dollars each, and to Edward Thompson, the sum of eight dollars, for their services as assistant committee clerks, the present session of the legislature.
