CITY COURT.—The court or either of the judges thereof authorised without a previous presentment, to hear and determine at their weekly sessions, all complaints for assault and battery, for keeping disorderly houses or houses of ill fame, for violations of the act of 1817, regulating licences to traders, and the supplements thereto, and for any other small offence, in the same manner and effect as cases now submitted to them during regular terms, after presentment, 75 1

 Directions as to taking recognisances in such cases, " 2

 Warden, weekly to furnish lists of persons confined for the above offences, " 3

 The accused may demand a jury trial—proceedings directed, " 4

 The Attorney General or his deputy may object to a decision in all such cases without a trial by jury, " 5

 Grand Jury may present and indict for any such offence not already tried, &c. " 6
