CHAPTER 78.

*A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to lay out and make a public Road in Allegany county.* Passed Feb 26, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Moses Rawlings, George Rizer, and John J. Hoffman, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to execute the law to which this is a supplement. Commissioners named

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners appointed by this act, are hereby authorized and empowered under the restrictions and in the manner prescribed by the aforesaid original act, to extend the said road from its intersection with the Cresapburgh road to the nearest and best point of intersection with the old national road at or near Cumberland, *Provided,* that this law shall not be so construed as to prevent the location of any canal or rail road by any company now authorised, or which may hereafter be authorised to construct the same, and that any such company as may wish to occupy the road hereby authorised, or any part thereof shall first only be required to provide another passable wagon road whensoever it may be found necessary to occupy the road hereby proposed to be opened or to reimburse such sums of money as may be expended in the execution of this law, to those respectively who may have paid the same, or to such person or persons as may rightfully claim by, through, or under them. Authorised to extend the road, &c.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the person or persons, applying for said road shall pay or cause to be paid all and every cost and expense of making and completing said road. Route for Canal & Rail road reserved
