All writs or other process issued by, or by justices of, shall be made returnable to the next monthly meeting of said court, except subpænas and attachments for witnesses.

Witnesses shall be allowed thirtythree and a third cents for each days attendance.

Each chief judge of, for all his services as such shall be entitled to retain out of the money received by him as hereinbefore provided, \$3 per day for every day he shall attend the sitting of said court.

Each of the other justices of, \$2 per day, for each day he attends &c.

Shall make report to the levy court or commissioners before the 1st day of June annually of said attendance, and of the whole amount of fees by them respectively received.

Said levy court or commissioners may appropriate the ballance in extra allowance to said justices, or otherwise, at discretion.

And shall in case of deficiency, levy upon the county and pay any ballance,

May give judgment against either plaintiff or defendant in any case, and the same proceedings may be had for recovery,

In case of vacancy, the executive shall by appointment supply the same,

Baltimore city exempt from the opperation of this act,

This act shall in no case affect suits brought before the 1st May 1889,
