REMOVAL OF CAUSES—Suits pending now or hereafter in any of the county courts as courts of equity, of the 4th or 6th judicial districts, may be, to the high court of chancery upon suggestion &c., and affidavit that it is not for delay, 346

REPEAL, Part of the act of 1834, ch. 251, and supplement thereto, (the militia law of the State,) 213

53d sect. of the original, repealed, " 1

Uniform of the general and staff officers prescribed, " 2

Volunteer companies, and field & staff officers may select their own uniforms, " 3

60th and 61st sections of original act repealed, " 4

The original act shall be forthwith enforced, " 4

The Governor shall have the militia law printed, &c., and a copy sent to every commissioned officer in the State, " 4

REPLEVIN,—On application, the district court shall issue writs of 201 13

And shall take a bond to the parties holding the property, to return the same, with costs of suit and all damages awarded by said court in the case, " 13

Upon service of such writ, the goods shall forthwith be appraised under oath, at the real value thereof; and if the amount exceeds \$100, all proceedings shall cease, and the plaintiff shall pay all costs, " 13
