thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated; to the Secretary of State for copying the laws of the said extraordinary session of nineteen hundred and one for the public printer, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated; for indexing the journals of the Senate and House of Delegates of the said extraordinary session of nineteen hundred and one, the sum of two hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated; for indexing the laws of the said extraordinary session of nineteen hundred and one, the sum of twenty-five dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated.

Appropriations how disbursed. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections fifteen and sixteen of Article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," as the said Article was enacted by the Act of 1896, Chapter two hundred and two, entitled "An Act to repeal Article 33, entitled 'Elections,' of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, and the several Acts and parts of Acts amendatory thereto, and to re-enact the said Article 33 with amendments, and as such Article was amended by Acts supplementary to said Act of 1896, Chapter two hundred and two; and also to add a new section to relate to Registration of Voters, and to come in after Section twenty-five of said Article 33, and to be known as Section 25A; also to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section thirty-seven of said Article 33, relating to nominations of candidates for public
