*General Assembly of the State of Maryland:*

In pursuance of the Constitution and laws of the State, I transmit to your Honorable Bodies, the following report of the operations of the Treasury Department for the fiscal year, ended 30th September, 1875.

### RECEIPTS.

The total receipts into the Treasury from all sources during the fiscal year, amounted to \$2,909,080.20, and the balance in the Treasury 30th September 1874, was \$565,106.59, making the aggregate amount in the Treasury during the fiscal year, \$3,474,186.79.

Of the amount received during the fiscal year, the sum of \$424,470.58, was from the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, in payment of the judgment of the State against said Company, recovered on account of a portion of the indebtedness for the one-fifth receipts from passengers on the Washington Branch Road, \$260,000.00 on account of the House of Correction State Loan, authorised by Act of 1874, chapter 233, \$100,000.00 from the State Normal School Loan, authorised by Act of 1874, chapter 469 and the sum of \$59,535.00, was received for insurance on Tobacco Warehouses destroyed by fire, leaving the receipts from ordinary sources for the fiscal year 1875, to be \$2,065,074.78.
