the holdings of its own stocks. The securities in the sinking fund of the new loan will be sufficient to carry the same without the levying of any tax therefor.

ASSESSABLE BASIS FOR STATE LEVY.

In Statement "K" will be found the assessed value of property for the State levy in 1913, amounting to \$1,007,881,475, together with the amount of such levy at 31 cents on each \$100, aggregating \$3,124,432.57. By a comparison of these figures with those of former years it will be seen that the basis shows a gradual and in some instances a very large increase. A comparison of any two years, however, in my judgment, would not be a safe basis upon which to form an intelligent opinion as to the equity and uniformity of such assessments, and I therefore submit the following table, covering the years 1877, 1897 and 1911 with those of 1913, the first three years being those immediately following new assessments:
