The General Assembly of Maryland:

In pursuance of Section 9 of Article 19 of the Code of Public General Laws, I herewith submit a statement of the financial affairs of the State for the Fiscal Year ended September 30th, 1915.

RECEIPTS.

In Statement "A" will be found the total gross receipts from all sources, amounting to \$11,015,497.36, to which should be added the cash balance in the Treasury proper on October 1st, 1914, \$1,076,962.19, aggregating \$12,092,459.55, viz:
