Honorable Sir:

I herewith submit the following report of the License Inspectors of the State of Maryland for the fiscal year beginning October 1st, 1932, and ending October 1st, 1933.

The total result of the inspection of licenses over the State of Maryland for the year 1932-33 amounted to \$74,302.31. Of this amount \$34,039.93 was reported in Baltimore City, which included a penalty of \$8,569.83. In the counties \$40,262.38 was reported, which included a penalty of \$6,777.04, and the total amount of penalty collected over the State was \$15,346.87.

Every county in the State has been visited by an Inspector during the past fiscal year. The following is a list of the different kind of licenses found to be necessary by the State License Inspectors in Baltimore City and the counties, and which had not been secured:
