## HONORABLE SIR:

I herewith submit the collowing report of the license inspectors of the State of Maryland for the fiscal year beginning July 1st, 1947, and ending June 30th, 1948.

The total result of the inspection of licenses over the State of Maryland for the fiscal year 1947-48 amounted to \$64,068.33. Of this amount \$36,980.96 was collected in the counties, which included a penalty of \$5,880.10. In Baltimore City \$27,187.37 was collected, which included penalty of \$11,415.12.
