\* The estimate for Income Tax on 1948 returns is based on contemplated continuation of the present rate of 2 per cent on ordinary income and increase in the corporation rate from 1½ per cent to 4 per cent. It is estimated that an increase in the rate on ordinary income from 2 per cent to 2½ per cent on 1948 returns as provided by the present law would add \$2,594,625.00 to the above estimate for Income Tax, all of which would go to the General Funds.
