In Charles, Queen Anne's, Somerset and Worcester Counties, the Board acts as hearing Officers, their decision being subject to appeal to the Circuit Courts of these counties. Two appeals were taken from the decisions of this Board to the Circuit Court of Queen Anne's County during the fiscal year.
