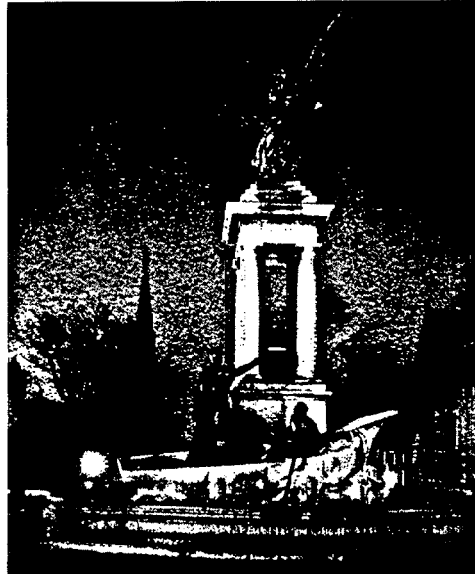


MONUMENT TO FRANCIS SCOTT KEY
