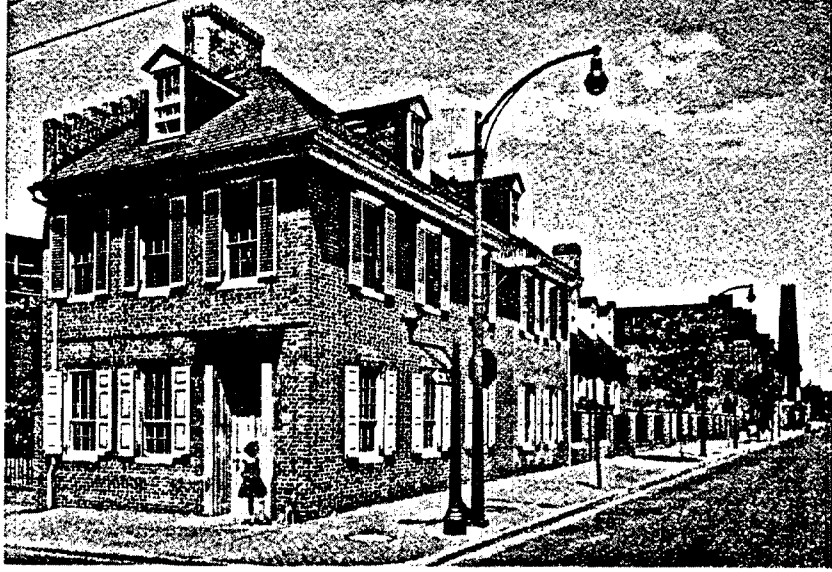




THE FLAG HOUSE
