"Effective July 1, 1981, the Maryland Higher Education Loan Corporation's activities were recorded in the enterprise funds and its beginning equity was

reclassified from the general fund balance to retained earnings in the enterprise funds.

Effective July 1, 1982, capital outlays for transportation projects are reported in Capital Outlays instead of Transportation.

During 1983 the Lottery returned \$8,000,000 to the General Fund. This return of contributed capital has been reported as an equity transfer.
