



The second USS Maryland

The second *USS Maryland* appeared at the start of the 20th century, during the period between the Spanish-American War and World War I.

Commissioned in 1905, she served in both the Atlantic and Pacific fleets and was later renamed *Frederick* so the name *Maryland* could be used for a newly authorized battleship. The former *Maryland* convoyed troops during World War I and transported them home after the Armistice was signed on November 11, 1918. She was decommissioned in the early 1920s.
