Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 384A of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Baltimore County," as enacted by the provision of Chapter 26 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1910, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, so as to read as follows:

384A. The State's attorney for Baltimore county is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint a clerk, at a compensation of sixty dollars per month, to be paid by the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, which said clerk shall perform such clerical work in the said State's attorney's office and such other work as he may be directed by the said State's Attorney.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 674.

An Acr to refund to W. Lake Robinson, of Dorchester county, Maryland, a sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of Maryland in favor of W. Lake Robinson, of Dorchester county, Maryland, for the sum of forty-seven dollars and fifty cents, being the amount erroneously paid into the State Treasury by the said W. Lake Robinson, as Clerk of the Circuit Court for Dorchester County, and accounted for in his official quarterly report, dated June first, nineteen hundred and ten, the same having received the recommendation of the Treasury officials.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
