upon him by law for the enforcement of the collection of all such taxes.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the terms "bailiff," "chief bailiff" and "chief of police," when used in this article, shall be construed, for the purposes of this article, to be synomymous and any and all rights, powers and duties conferred or imposed upon a "bailiff" or "chief bailiff" in this article, shall be vested in and exercised by the chief of police, and any and all rights, powers and duties conferred or imposed upon any sub-bailiff in this article, shall be vested in and exercised by the chief of police or any police officer holding office under this act.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
