be received for such license shall be paid over to the Treasurer of the Board of County Commissioners of Wicomico County, to be applied by him to the building and support of the public schools in said county.

- SEC. 3. And be if further enacted, That it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Wicomico County to issue a license to any person or persons, for the purpose of catching crabs with trot lines in any of the waters of said county, who has not been a resident thereof for a period of not less than twelve months immediately prior to the date of the issue of such license.
- SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this act shall upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace for Wicomico county, be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), in the discretion of said justice.

CHAPTER 775.

An Act to repeal section 165 of Chapter 231 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland passed at the January Session of 1910, title "Charles County," sub-title "Roads and Bridges."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 165 of Chapter 231 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the January Session of 1910, title "Charles County," sub-title "Roads and Bridges," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 776.

An Act to provide for the issue of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000.00) of State of Maryland bonds for the purchase of land and the erection and construction of buildings including dormitories for students, for the Maryland State Normal School, and for the sale of the Maryland State Normal School, and for the sale of the Maryland State Normal School.
