

ARTICLE XVI—MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

ALMSHOUSE.

1. Trustees of the poor a body corporate; corporate name; powers; seal.
2. Trustees of the poor, their number and appointment; term of office; removals, vacancies, how filled.
3. Trustees of the poor, oath; by whom administered.
4. Trustees of the poor, refusal or delay to qualify; penalty; who exempt; who ineligible.
5. Overseer, when and how appointed; his salary; other servants and officers.
