eral Laws of Maryland, title "County Commissioners," subtitle "Draining Lands," so far as the same is applicable to tax ditches and drains situate wholly within Somerset county, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 803.

An Act to repeal Chapter 627 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1908, being "An Act to repeal section 195 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Hagerstown,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Chapter 627 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1908, being "An Act to repeal section 195 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Hagerstown,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

- 195. The Mayor and Council shall annually levy on the assessable property of the town all needful taxes for general purposes and such further sums that are now or may hereafter be authorized by law for the liquidation of indebtedness; the said levy shall not be made in gross, but shall designate the particular heads for which it is to be expended; such taxes when levied shall be a lien upon property as now provided by law; and shall be collected as State and county taxes are collected, unless the Mayor and Council shall adopt some other mode by ordinance for the collection of the same.
- SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 804.

An Acr to repal and re-enact with amendments section 23 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Oysters," as amended by Chapter 413 of the Acts of 1910.
