4. To the Florence Crittenton Home for Fallen Women, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1913, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1914.

5. To the Home of Good Shepherd for Colored Girls, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1913, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1914.

6. To the Saint Peter Clavier Colored Industrial School, the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1913, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1914.
