

## CHAPTER 463.

AN ACT concerning the retirement from regular duty of public school teachers in Allegany county and providing salaries for teachers retired; providing for a fund out of which said salaries be paid; and creating the Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement Fund of Allegany county for the management and distribution of such fund.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That there shall be a board to be known as the Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement Fund of Allegany County, to be composed of five persons, who shall serve without compensation for their duties as members of said board. The said Board of Trustees shall be composed of the County Superintendent of Public Instruction, and the President of the Board of School Commissioners, and three members of the teaching force of Allegany county who shall be elected in the following manner: On the third Monday in November in each year, beginning in the year 1912, the members of the teaching force of Allegany county shall deposit with the said Board of Trustees a sealed containing the names of three teachers, at least one of whom shall be a male principal, representing his or her choice for membership of the said Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall examine said ballots and give to each teacher receiving a vote credit therefor, and the three teachers receiving the highest number of votes under the said ballots shall become members of the said Board of Trustees on the fifteenth day of January next following the date of their election. The Board of Trustees shall publicly announce the result of said election not later than the fifteenth day of December next following the date said ballots were deposited. Provided, however, that on the third Monday of May, 1912, three members of the teaching force of Allegany county shall be elected in the manner provided, except the said ballots shall be deposited with the Board of School Commissioners, which board shall examine said ballots and give to each teacher receiving a vote credit therefor, and the three teachers receiving the highest number of votes under said ballots shall be members of said Board of Trustees until the members elected in November, in the year 1912, shall become members of said Board of Trustees. The Board of School Commissioners shall publicly announce the result of said election not later than June 15, 1912. As soon as practicable after the passage of this act the president of the
