

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That to pay and cancel the said bonds issued under this act the said County Commissioners of Talbot County shall annually levy upon the assessable property of Talbot county a tax sufficient to pay the two bonds maturing during each and every year and interest on all the bonds issued under this act, outstanding and unpaid, and the amount of the said tax shall be separately kept by the said County Commissioners of Talbot County and designated as the Miles River Bridge Construction Loan Fund.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the bonds hereby authorized to be issued shall be exempt from all county and municipal taxation in Talbot county and that the coupons for the interest thereon shall be receivable by the County Treasurer of Talbot County in payment of county taxes.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the proceeds from the said bonds, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose herein mentioned, shall be applied to the construction or reconstruction of the aforesaid Miles River Bridge, and the balance of the proceeds from the sale of said bonds, if any, shall be retained by the County Commissioners for Talbot County for the use of the general public road fund and the payment of expenses incident to this bond issue.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 578.

AN ACT to add new sections to Chapter 178 of the Acts of 1896, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Town of Ridgely, Caroline county, Maryland," by providing for the construction of a system of sewers and disposal works, and method for meeting the cost thereof by the issuance and sale of bonds by the Commissioners of Ridgely; by providing for the payment of interest upon and redemption of said bonds, and authorizing the said commissioners to condemn such lands and rights as may be necessary for the building and operation of said system of sewers and disposal works.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Chapter 178 of the Acts of 1896, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Town of Ridgely, Caroline county, Maryland," be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of
