1. There shall be a state board of forestry, consisting of seven members, the governor, comptroller, president of Johns Hopkins University, president of the Maryland State Agricultural College, State Geologist, and one citizen of the State known to be interested in the advancement of forestry, and one practical lumberman engaged in the manufacture of lumber within this State, who shall be appointed by the governor, to serve for a term of two years, which board shall act without compensation, save for actual necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.

2. There shall be appointed by the board of forestry, a state forester, who shall have a practical knowledge of forestry, and who shall be a trained forester; his compensation shall be fixed by the board, and shall not exceed \$2,000 per annum, and reasonable traveling and field expenses incurred in the performance of his official duties. He shall, under the general supervision of the state board of forestry, have direction of all forest interests, and all matters pertaining to forestry within the jurisdiction of the State. He shall have charge of all forest war
