23. Licenses for sale of liquors at horse races.

Hawkers and Peddlers.

24. When license necessary and when unnecessary; not to apply to Prince George's, Anne Arundel or Cecil counties.
25. Rates of such license; not to apply to Prince George's, Anne Arundel, Cecil or Garrett counties.
26. Granted only to single persons; good only within county where issued.
