

- 259. Orphans' court may make rules for hearing such cases.
- 260. Power to summon executors, administrators and guardians alleged to be in default to render accounts; notice to.
- 261. Power to authorize compromise.
- 262. Orphans' court not to exercise any jurisdiction not expressly conferred.

#### Register of Wills.

- 263. Bond of.
