- New registration in the counties in 1914. Transcribing names into new books.
- 27. Registration in Baltimore city in 1910 and biennially thereafter. Removal certificate. Disqualifled voters, etc.
- 28. Affidavit in cases of removal from State. Proviso.
- Register of names of persons coming into the State with intent to become citizens; cost of such registration.
- 30. To whom section 29 shall not apply.

Intermediate Registration.

- Revision of registration in the counties. Certificates of removal. Oath of applicant for removal certificate.
- 32. Registers to be made to agree and be signed.
- 33. Board of registry to make out list of persons supposed to be dead or suspected to be disqualified.
- . 34. Meeting for revision.
- 35. Hearing of persons to whom notices were sent.
- 36. List of registered or erased names to be printed and posted.
- 37. Persons aggrieved may file petitions.
- 38. Vacancies, how filled.
- 39. Revision of registration in Annapolis.
- Inspection of registers may be permitted in presence of some member of the board of supervisors.

Nominations.

- 41. How nominations may be made.
- Nominations by conventions or primaries.
- 43. Nominations otherwise than by conventions or primaries.
- 44. Filing of certificates of nomination.
- 45. Such certificates to contain but one nominee for each office.
- 46. Such certificates to be kept for two years.

- 47. When such certificates shall be filed. Exceptions.

- 60. Delivery of ballots to judges of election.

- 62. Judges of election to keep the peace.
- 63. Opening of polling places in city of Baltimore and in the counties. Substitute of absent judges or clerks. Oath of such substitutes.
- 64. Parties having candidates shall have the right to keep challengers or watchers. Penalty for violating the law in this respect.
