

26. New registration in the counties in 1914. Transcribing names into new books.
27. Registration in Baltimore city in 1910 and biennially thereafter. Removal certificate. Disqualified voters, etc.
28. Affidavit in cases of removal from State. Proviso.
29. Register of names of persons coming into the State with intent to become citizens; cost of such registration.
30. To whom section 29 shall not apply.

#### Intermediate Registration.

31. Revision of registration in the counties. Certificates of removal. Oath of applicant for removal certificate.
32. Registers to be made to agree and be signed.
33. Board of registry to make out list of persons supposed to be dead or suspected to be disqualified.
34. Meeting for revision.
35. Hearing of persons to whom notices were sent.
36. List of registered or erased names to be printed and posted.
37. Persons aggrieved may file petitions.
38. Vacancies, how filled.
39. Revision of registration in Annapolis.
40. Inspection of registers may be permitted in presence of some member of the board of supervisors.

#### Nominations.

41. How nominations may be made.
42. Nominations by conventions or primaries.
43. Nominations otherwise than by conventions or primaries.
44. Filing of certificates of nomination.
45. Such certificates to contain but one nominee for each office.
46. Such certificates to be kept for two years.

47. When such certificates shall be filed. Exceptions.

64. Parties having candidates shall have the right to keep challengers or watchers. Penalty for violating the law in this respect.
