ARTICLE XX.

CONSTABLES.

1.

A person appointed constable who neglects to take the oath within thirty days after his appointment must be held to have refused the office. This section is mandatory. This section construed in connection with article 1, section 7, of the constitution, and article 70, section 11, of the code; the latter section in so far as it conflicts with this section does not apply to constables. Little v. Schul, 118 Md. 465.

In view of section 206 of the act of 1898, chapter 123 (Baltimore City Charter), it was competent for the legislature to confer upon the city of Baltimore the power to pass ordinances changing the duties and compensation of constables. Gould v. Baltimore, 120 Md. 535.
