32. The Board of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to issue a State loan in the sum of eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for the purpose of erecting and constructing additional buildings for the care of the insane at Springfield State Hospital at Sykesville, at the Maryland Hospital for the Insane at Catonsville, to be hereafter styled "Spring Grove State Hospital"; at the Hospital for the Negro Insane of Maryland at Crownsville, to be hereafter styled "Crownsville State Hospital"; for the erection and construction of additional building and the purchase of additional lands for the care of the feeble-minded at the Maryland Asylum and Training School for Feeble-Minded at Owings Mills, to be hereafter styled "Rosewood State Training School"; for the purchase of lands and the erection and construction of a hospital for the insane on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, to be styled "Eastern Shore State Hospital."†

*The act of 1912, ch. 361 (article 91, section 47A), authorizes the Roads Commission to expend the unexpended balance of Series "E" of the certificates of indebtedness dated February 1, 1912, and to borrow on Series "F," dated February 1, 1913.
