And the returns made by the judges of election shall set forth on blank forms to be furnished by the Supervisors of Elections the number of "first choice" votes cast for each candidate, followed horizontally by a statement of the number of "second choice" votes cast by his supporters for each of the other candidates. Such tabular statement and returns shall be substantially in the following form, the names of candidates to be arranged thereon in the order in which they appear upon the ballot:
