Live Stock Patrol.

45. For the purpose of further carrying out the provisions of section fifteen (15) of this Article; and to pay a live stock patrol along the State borders, which is hereby authorized and shall be named by the Chief Veterinary Inspector and shall receive such compensation as may be stipulated by him, the duty of said patrol being to prevent any live stock from being shipped or brought into this State which may be affected with any contagious or infectious disease, contrary to the laws regulating the shipment or bringing of such live stock into this State, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars annually is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be necessary.
