39G. The actual cash proceeds of the sale of certificates of indebtedness to be issued under the act of 1914, ch. 267, shall be paid to the Treasurer of this State upon the warrant of the Comptroller, and such proceeds shall be used exclusively, as far as the same are required for the purposes set forth in Sections 33-39 of said Article 91 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, and as provided in the act of 1914, ch. 267, to wit: The Comptroller shall immediately upon the sale and payment of said bonds or certificates of indebtedness first return to and credit the Treasury proper for whatever appropriations, advances or loans that may have been made from the same as provided in Section 6 of the act of 1914, ch. 267, the balance of proceeds of said issue of bonds or certificates of indebtedness to be used in the manner and for the purposes set forth in Sections 33-39 of said Article 91 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, and as further provided in the act of 1914, ch. 267; and the State Roads Commission shall appropriate for use in the City of Baltimore One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000) for a new bridge over the Patapsco river and for paving in Baltimore City as hereinbelow provided, and in the several Counties of the State of Maryland Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) of the funds arising from the issue of bonds or certificates of indebtedness herein provided; of which Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000), the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) shall be allotted to the several Counties on the basis of county road mileage as shown in the table set forth in Section 39H hereof in the same proportion and manner as provided for the expenditure of a State Roads Loan created by Chapter 141 of the Acts of 1908, it being the intention of this Act to provide for this additional sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), to be used in the furtherance of the purposes for which the State Roads Commission was created, and in the same manner as the State Roads Loan of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) created by Section 40 of this article, except that the funds hereby provided for shall be at all times at the disposal of the said State Roads Commission, to be spent as rapidly as it may economically do in order to complete as quickly as possible the system of roads undertaken to be constructed by the State, the balance of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to be used as specially provided by the act of 1914, ch. 267.
