- 439A. Unnatural sexual practices; penalty; indictment.

State Board of Prison Control.

- 623-625. Appointment; term of office; vacancies; removal; oath; bond; secretary; employees.
- 626-627. Powers, duties, franchises, property, etc., of directors of penitentiary, and managers of house of correction, to vest in board; books, records, etc., to be transferred to latter.
- 628-629. To have power and control over penitentiary and house of correction; incidental powers. Title to property; contracts; may not execute mortgage.

- 629A-629J. State farm; prisoners may be required to work thereon—payments to credit of; good behavior. Repeal of inconsistent local laws. Sub-title not applicable to Baltimore City Jail.

630. System of prison labor to be established; surplus earnings to prisoners.
