118. Permitting ballot to be seen, except as otherwise provided; penalty.
119. Destroying or delaying delivery of ballot; penalty.
120. Taking intoxicating drinks into registration offices during hours of election; penalty.
121. Selling liquors and other intoxicating drinks on election day; penalty.
