

return shall sign a certificate that the same is correct in all respects. If any Supervisor shall decline to sign such return the same action shall be taken by him as is required to be taken by a judge of election in a similar case.

The Supervisors of Elections shall then proceed to sit as a Board of Canvassers, shall canvass the returns made by them of mail ballots counted by them as aforesaid and shall canvass and add up such votes in the total of votes canvassed and counted by them. The Board of Canvassers shall not conclude the canvass of votes at any election until after the time for counting and canvassing votes by mail as aforesaid shall have expired and until such mail ballots as they shall receive from the Supervisors of Elections shall be counted and canvassed as aforesaid, but in all other respects the Board of Canvassers for the several counties and for Baltimore City shall proceed as now required by law.

234. Whenever the condition which resulted in the issuing of the proclamation hereinbefore provided for terminate, it shall be the duty of the Governor, as soon as is convenient and proper, by proclamation, published as provided in Section 225 of this Article, to end the suspension of the election laws, and the provisions of this sub-title shall become inoperative until such time as a new proclamation of suspension is issued.

235. Whenever possible, the existing election laws and the provisions of this sub-title shall be construed together in such a way as to promote the purpose for which this sub-title is intended, to the end that the citizens of the State shall not be deprived of their right or opportunity to vote because of service, as herein provided, for their State or the United States. Whenever the provisions of this sub-title are enforced at any election the Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City shall be entitled to receive in addition to the compensation now paid to them the further sum of \$200 each for every such election, and the Supervisors of Elections of the several counties in addition to the compensation now allowed them shall each be entitled to receive the additional sum of \$25 each for every such election. The Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City and of the several counties shall be allowed such further sum for expenses and clerical hire in the performance of the duties imposed upon them by this sub-title as may be reasonable and necessary. All said expenses shall be paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the County Commissioners of the several counties respectively in precisely the same way as compensation and similar election expenses are now provided to be paid by law.

236. Any person who shall wilfully sign any false certificate or application, and any person who shall in any way wilfully do any act contrary to the terms and provisions of this sub-title with intent to cast an
