No justice shall charge, take and receive any fees or compensation for mileage, or journey fee for the performance of any duty or business relating to his office as justice of the peace except what the party may agree to pay to a justice going from his office to take the acknowledgment of a deed or other instrument of writing.

24. Notaries public shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees, to wit:

For protesting any note, draft, bill of exchange or check for non-acceptance or non-payment.....	\$2 00
For drawing all proceedings, exceeding two sides.....	50
For drawing all proceedings, exceeding two sides, per side.....	25
For registering or copying proceedings, for every side.....	10
