

any person or corporation doing any of the things prohibited by this section under and by virtue of a permit issued to him or it by the State Roads Commission as aforesaid shall be immune from prosecution for the commission of any acts under the terms of this section.

25. Any trees grown in the State Nurseries not required for roadside planting may be used for planting on the State Forest Reserve or may be furnished to any land owner of this State at not less than the cost of production; provided such trees shall be planted according to plans approved by the State Forester.¹

26. There is hereby appropriated the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3,500) annually for the fiscal years 1907 and 1908 for carrying out the provisions of this article, and for the payment of salaries and expenses herein provided for.

27. Every person, his aiders, abettors and counsellors, who shall wilfully, negligently, recklessly, wrongfully or maliciously enter upon lands or premises, not his or their own, and, without the permission or authority of the owners of said lands or premises, shall cut, burn or otherwise injure and destroy or cause or procure to be cut, burned or otherwise injured and destroyed, any merchantable trees or timber thereon, shall be liable to the party or parties injured or aggrieved thereby to an amount equal to double the value of such trees or timber so cut, burned, or otherwise injured or destroyed, such damages to be recovered in a civil action, as in any other case.

28. The State Board of Forestry is merely authorized to purchase land out of moneys standing to the credit of the Forest Reserve Fund, at a price exceeding five dollars (\$5) per acre if necessary, for the establishment of a State Forest Nursery for the purpose of growing forest trees for planting on the State Reserves, and for distribution to private land owners at cost, to encourage tree planting.

29. For the maintenance, use and extension of the work under the State Board of Forestry, and for forest fire protection, there is hereby appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), annually out of any moneys in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be placed to the credit of the State Forest Reserve Fund.
