The mileage of members and officers of the house of delegates and senate of Maryland shall be fixed and established as follows, that is to say: The senators and delegates from Allegany county shall each receive the sum of eighty dollars; those from Anne Arundel county, except from Annapolis, the sum of fifteen dollars; those from Baltimore city, the sum of fifteen dollars; those from Baltimore county, the sum of nineteen dollars; those from Calvert county, the sum of fifty dollars; those from Caroline county, the sum of seventy-four dollars; those from Carroll county, the sum of thirty dollars; those from Cecil county, the sum of thirty-six dollars; those from Charles county, the sum of forty-eight dollars; those from Dorchester county, the sum of ninety dollars; those from Frederick county, the sum of thirty-three dollars; those from Garrett county, the sum of one hundred and ten dollars; those from Harford county, the sum of twentyseven dollars; those from Howard county, the sum of eighteen dollars; those from Kent county, the sum of sixty-four dollars; those from Montgomery county, the sum of twenty-six dollars; those from Prince George's county, the sum of twenty-five dollars; those from Queen Anne's county, the sum of sixty-eight dollars; those from St. Mary's county, the sum of seventy-one dollars; those from Somerset county, the sum of ninety-two
