Upon the taking effect of this Act<sup>1</sup> the Executive and Administrative Departments, boards, commissions, institutions and officers of the State Government of Maryland mentioned in this Act shall be organized, established, continued or abolished, and shall have and exercise the rights, powers, duties, obligations and functions, as herein provided.
