INSPECTIONS.

Illuminating Oils.

1. Test.
2. Stamp upon head of barrel.
3. Oil below test; penalty.
4. Action by purchaser.
5. Seller to answer for accidents.
6. Privilege of reference in case of seizure.
7. False report; penalty.
8. Oils to which these provisions do not apply.

Tobacco.

- 9-16. Inspector; duties; bond; employees; salaries; quarterly report to comptroller; hours of labor.
- 17-24. Hogsheads to be numbered, marked and weighed; how inspection conducted. Arbitration of disputes concerning samples; award.
- 25-27. False packing; treatment of samples; cost of hogshead; hogshead redrawn or reviewed.
28. Tampering with samples.
- 29-30. Lost certificates.
- 31-32. Condemned or stayed tobacco.
33. Reconditioning.
34. Charge required for inspection other than above provided.
35. Removal of stayed tobacco.
36. Cooperation.
37. Scrap tobacco.
- 38-39. Tobacco in warehouse for four years.
40. Size of hogsheads.
41. Renting storage.
42. Free storage.
43. Charge for storage after six months.
44. Wharves in front of warehouses.

State Horticultural Department.

56. Its purpose.
