80. The governor is authorized and directed to appoint a commission to consist of three members of the Baltimore bar to be recommended to the governor by the bar association of Baltimore city. It shall be the duty of said commission to make a thorough examination of the constitution and laws of this State relating to the method of appointment, jurisdiction, practice and procedure of justices of the peace for Baltimore city and to prepare and submit to the next general assembly of this State a report embodying the results of said examination. Said report shall include their recommendations, if any, for improving said laws, and they shall draft such amendments to the constitution and laws of the State as they may deem advisable.
