Every person owning or operating any such motor vehicle in violation of any of the provisions of this sub-title, or in violation of the rules and regulation aforesaid of the Public Service Commission, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction subject to a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each first offense, and a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each second offense or subsequent offense.
