For serving scire facias, including the person summoned, for each person summoned75
For serving Citation, for each person summoned75
For executing a warrant of re-survey, per day	3.00
For summoning evidences to prove the bounds of land, for each person summoned75
If empowered to swear evidences, for every witness sworn by him.	.20
For serving subpoena and return75
For keeping a prisoner in jail and finding him victuals, per day30
For serving a writ of possession in ejectment and return	3.00
For serving an ejectment and return	2.00
For serving an attachment of contempt and return	2.00
For serving writ of estrepement or injunction and return	2.00
For serving <i>ne exeat</i> and return	3.00
For serving a copy of declaration, short note, nar and notice or process20
For summoning appraisers to value goods taken by attachment, <i>feri facias</i> or <i>replevin</i> , for each appraiser summoned75

For serving an attachment on judgment or execution or return15

For attendance, per day, after the first day	3.00
