#### General Duties of Clerks.

**1A.** The Clerks of the several Courts referred to in Section 1 of this Article shall not make any charge for a copy of any paper or record in his office whether certified or not when the same is requested by a man or woman formerly in the Military, Air or Naval service of the United States Government to be used in connection with any claim such person may have against said government, provided such paper is requested either by the claimant in person or by the said government.

It being agreed by counsel that docket entries required by this section were sent to another county and attachment laid, case was removed to a third county, but nothing in record to show docket entries filed in second county; held court in third county had jurisdiction, since court from which case was removed had jurisdiction. *Lockerman v. **9.** Notices of liens for taxes payable to the United States of America and Certificates discharging such liens shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County, and the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City, within which the property subject to such lien is situated.
