

State against erosion by the action of the elements or other causes and for improvement of said waterfront and waterways.

(b) To co-operate in carrying into effect such plans or recommendations for the improvement or development of waterfront property and waterways within the State as may be adopted by the Legislature.

(c) To represent the State of Maryland in convention or conference of associations or bodies formed for the purpose of discussion of such problems and to become members of such associations or bodies as representatives of the State and to represent the State in all matters affecting waterways and/or waterfront property.

26. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as limiting or curtailing the powers of any existing governmental agency of the State of Maryland.¹
