The Commissioners of Denton are hereby fully authorized and empowered to construct, establish and maintain in working order a sewerage system in the town of Denton for the collection, transmission and disposal of drainage and sewage from the houses and other buildings and cess pools, wells, sinks and other receptacles for sewage and drainage in said town, including also, if the said Commissioners of Denton shall at any time so determine, water and other drainage from the streets, lanes, roads and alleys thereof, and that the Commissioners of Denton shall have full power of determining when and where, in what order and under which streets, roads, lanes and alleys the sewers and drains shall be constructed or laid, and to make contracts for the construction thereof, except that
